National Cancer Registry Ireland (NCRI)

- NCRI, a statutory body funded by Department of Health, began telling the story of cancer in Ireland in 1994
- Our dedicated experienced staff of >50 tell the story by...
 - bringing together accurate cancer data from every person diagnosed with cancer in Ireland
 - recording & reporting on all new cases of cancer (37,591 per year 2012-2014)
 - reporting on all cancer deaths (8,655 per year 2011-2013)
 - reporting on cancer survivors (139,526 patients still alive at the end of 2014)
 - disseminating cancer information & maintaining an active cancer research programme

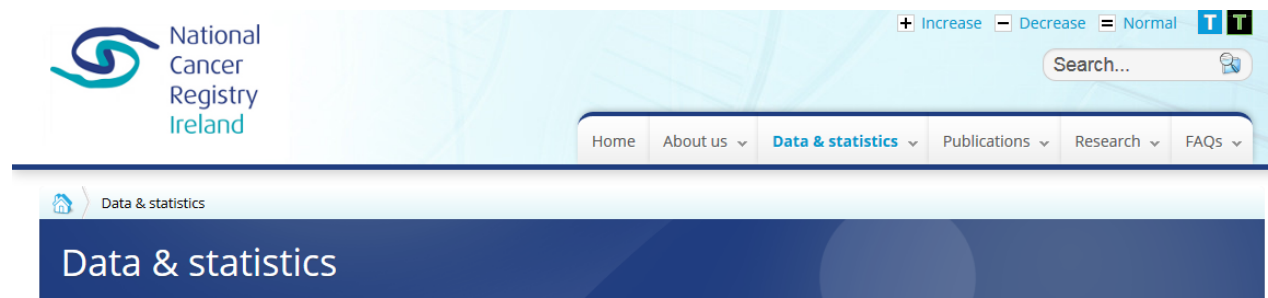



About our data

Information on every new case of cancer diagnosed in the Republic of Ireland is collected by [trained nurses](#) and maintained in a central register to provide a national cancer dataset on the incidence of cancer in Ireland. This data is subject to rigorous quality assurance, including external checks developed by the International Association for Research on Cancer, ensuring that our data conforms to the highest international standards in cancer registration. Datasets are produced routinely for [annual incidence reports](#), [specific research projects](#), for service planning and evaluation and other general enquires.
